

FIRST READING

Psalm 27

- 1 The LORD is my light and my salvation;
whom then shall I fear?
the LORD is the strength of my life;
of whom then shall I be afraid?
- 2 When evildoers came upon me to eat up my flesh,
it was they, my foes and my adversaries, who
stumbled and fell.
- 3 Though an army should encamp against me,
yet my heart shall not be afraid;
- 4 And though war should rise up against me,
yet will I put my trust in him.
- 5 One thing have I asked of the LORD;
one thing I seek;
that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my
life;
- 6 To behold the fair beauty of the LORD
and to seek him in his temple.
- 7 For in the day of trouble he shall keep me safe
in his shelter;
he shall hide me in the secrecy of his dwelling
and set me high upon a rock.
- 8 Even now he lifts up my head
above my enemies round about me.
- 9 Therefore I will offer in his dwelling an oblation
with sounds of great gladness;
I will sing and make music to the LORD.
- 10 Hearken to my voice, O LORD, when I call;
have mercy on me and answer me.
- 11 You speak in my heart and say, "Seek my face.
Your face, LORD, will I seek.
- 12 Hide not your face from me,
nor turn away your servant in displeasure.
- 13 You have been my helper;
cast me not away;
do not forsake me, O God of my salvation.

- 14 Though my father and my mother forsake me,
the LORD will sustain me.
- 15 Show me your way, O LORD;
lead me on a level path, because of my enemies.
- 16 Deliver me not into the hand of my adversaries,
for false witnesses have risen up against me,
and also those who speak malice.
- 17 What if I had not believed
that I should see the goodness of the LORD
in the land of the living!
- 18 O tarry and await the LORD's pleasure;
be strong, and he shall comfort your heart;
wait patiently for the LORD.
